Eighteenth Annual Report of the Indian Phytopathological Society for the year 1964.

Mr. President, members of the I. P. S., ladies and gentlemen.

I am presenting herewith the 18th Annual Report of the Society for the year 1964. Sixty nine new members joined the Society, 3 as lifemembers and 66 as ordinary members. Eight members discontinued due to nonpayment of the subscription during the year. It is a matter of great regret that four distinguished members of the Society expired during the period under report. The total number of the members at the end of the year was 369 and that of subscribers 222. Subscription is due from only a few members now.

During the year, volume XVI (4), 1963; XVII, Nos. 1,2 and 3, 1964 of Indian Phytopathology have been issued. The financial position of the Society continued to be satisfactory. Besides, a sum of Rs. 7,500/- continues to remain in the form of National Savings Certificates. The amount to the credit of the Society in the Saving Bank Account with M/s National and Grindlays Bank Ltd. (Llyods Branch), New Delhi and cash in hand taken together on 31-11-1964 was Rs. 16,650.63 Thus the assets of the Society amounts to Rs. 24,150.63. In addition, several cheques are in the process of collection.

During the year the receipt amounts to Rs. 24,420.30 and expenditure to Rs. 22,248.02, thus showing a balance of Rs. 2,172.28 in favour of the Society. It may be mentioned that no financial assistance was received by the Society from any source during the year. We have paid the cost of printing vol. XVI, Nos. 1, 2, 3 and 4 1963 and vol. XVII, No. 1 and 2, 1964 and also of symposium volume of (Bulletin No. 1) 1963. The printing of the journal has been in the hands of M/s Kapoor Art Press, New Delhi.

Three council meetings were held during the year.

I am glad to inform you that, so far 9 foreign members and 46 members in India have expressed their desire to become fellows of the Society. They will be introduced in the morning session after coffee. Also, three eminent scientists have been elected Honorary Fellows of the Society.

- 3. 22-2-1964. Dr. M. J. Thirumalachar, Hindustan Antibiotics, Pimpri—"Mycological aspects of antibiotic production".
- 4.24-11-1964. DR. T. JOHNSON--Cereal Research Laboratory, Murree, Pakistan. "Cereal rusts".

Narasimhan, for kindly accepting our invitation to deliver the Second Mundkur Memorial Lecture inspite of his personal inconvenience and long and tiresome journey from Poona.
