PROCEEDINGS OF THE GENEARL BODY MEETING

University of Mysore, Mysuru, Karnataka

FEBRUARY 04, 2023

Dr. Robin Gogoi, Secretary heartily welcomed Dr. Rakesh Pandey, President of the Society, and requested to chair the meeting. He also expressed the proud privilege to welcome all the members of the Society for showing their keen interest in the affairs of the Society by coming over to Mysuru and attending the Annual General Body Meeting of the Society. With the approval of the President, Dr. Robin Gogoi proceeded with the agenda items as follows.

The Secretary briefed the house about the various activities of the Society undertaken during the year. The following decisions were taken by the GB.

Proposal of the institution of new awards

- IPS Eminent Scientist Biennial Award in Phytoplasma Research: The proposal has been
 endorsed and suggested to communicate Dr. G.P. Rao for his consent with regards to
 modification in the title of the award as IPS Eminent Researcher Award in Phytoplasma
 and fastidious prokaryotes.
- Award in the memory of Late Joymallya Maji: The proposal of Dr. Manas Dev Maji has not been considered due irrelevant subject areas of the award.
- Prof. G. Rangaswami and Prof. A. Mahadevan Award: proposed by Dr. R. Sridhar: The
 proposal has not been considered as the endowment amount proposed by the donor
 amounting Rs. One Lakh only is not sufficient as per guideline of the Society to institute any
 award. Communication in this regard was made to the proposer and proposer declined.
- Prof. A.K. Roy Award proposed by Dr. A.N. Singh: Till date, no response received from the
 proposer of this award. Hence, the proposal has been declined.
- Awards: In case, the applicant(s) is unable to meet required score for consideration, then
 EC is empowered to nominate/recommend eminent plant pathologists of the country for
 the awards to avoid laps of the award in the year. Minimum 3 nominations are required for
 evaluation of the applications received for any award.
 - For each award lecture, it is mandatory to submit a review article for publication in the journal *Indian Phytopathology* before delivering and receiving the award lecture. If the awardees failed to do so, his/her conferred award will be cancelled.
- Proposal for publication of new journal by the Society: The proposal was declined. The
 present journal Indian Phytopathology will be continued and also suggested to explore the

possibility of incorporating the various areas related to crop protection. The proposal to increase the number of issues was discussed with the present publisher. However, the publisher has not agreed with the proposal till the journal gets its international impact factor. Thus, there the volume numbers per year will not be increased.

- IPS Books: The proposal for the following edited books were approved.
 - i. Genomics of Plant Pathogens: yet to be decided
 - ii. Current Protocols in Plant Pathology: Editors- Drs. Bikash Mandal, Kalyan K. Mondal, M.S. Saharan and Vishal Somvanshi

The publication of the book from the Society should be viewed by the Editorial Board. The Editorial board will find out eminent person related to the area of the book from India/abroad, while inviting the interest through IPS website. The Plagiarism has to be checked at time of submission of the book chapters.

Disease compendia:

The pricing of the compendia was discussed. It was suggested to send letter to all SAUs and ICAR institutions to subscribe/purchase the books/compendia published by the Society. It was also suggested to calculate cost involved and resources generated from the Society from the last five years through various publications.

- Members' Directory: The directory has to be prepared alphabetically and at the end, year
 wise list of office bearers for different categories should be indexed.
- Revision of constitution and Byelaws of the Society: On the basis of comments received,
 the Constitution and Byelaws will be revised and published. If any major changes
 suggested, approval from the byelaws revision committee will be taken online. The
 members suggested that it should be presented in the next GB.
- The re-orientation of the zonal chapters was discussed. No major changes required.
 However, it has been suggested that state wise/zone wise list of members will be prepared and appropriate committee will look the matter.
- Court case between Dr. Vaibhav Kumar Singh and Dr. Dinesh Singh & others

GB approved the continual of Dr. Vaibhav Kumar Singh in the Society.

In response to the earlier EC decision dated 19th December 2022, all the concerned persons were requested to resolve the court cases amicably through legal mediation as early as possible. In response to that request, Dr. Dinesh Singh through his mail dated December 23, 2022 refused to accept the proposal for settlement saying that the case is not pertaining to Dr. Vaibhav Kumar Singh and former EC members. He stated that it is the case between Dr. Vaibhav Kumar Singh and IPS. Dr. M.P. Thakur has also endorsed Dr. Dinesh Singh view through mail dated December 23, 2022. The mail of Dr. Vaibhav Kumar Singh dated January 4, 2023, also declined to settle the court cases. The members were not agreed with their opinions/responses. General Body agreed with EC decided to not entertain any further discussion pertaining to this matter in the Society. GB also took the decision that the Society will not provide any financial support now onward.
