Guidelines

Abstract for Oral/Poster presentation should be maximum of 250 words, including the title, authors, and address. The abstract should be prepared in MS word, Times New Roman, 12 font sizes, and single space leaving a 1-inch margin on the left and right sides of the page. The technical session to which the abstract belongs should be clearly indicated at the top of the page and also in the registration form, email-ID and contact number of the corresponding author should be clearly given in the abstract.

- Impact of climate change, emerging and re-emerging diseases, epidemiology and forewarning for plant disease management
